

## Logan and Vera Dean Memorial Scholarship

Through the generosity of the late Logan and Vera Dean, and in memory of Mrs. Dean's twenty-six years of service as an educator at Troy Grade School, four scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each are offered to students graduating from Troy High School. Students should apply and will be selected during the spring semester of their senior year at Troy High School. Winners will be recognized during the annual awards assembly and/or at the graduation ceremony. The scholarship award check will be issued to the college of the student's choice anytime after the student achieves junior-level status, working toward a bachelor's degree. Students should contact the USD #429 District Office at any time when junior status has been achieved, but no later than their final semester of work toward a bachelor's degree to make arrangements for payment of the award.

**Who may apply:** This scholarship is available to students who graduate from Troy High School who have attended Troy Grade School for any two full semesters in grades kindergarten through grade six. Students applying must be planning to work toward a bachelor's degree. Special consideration may be granted to well-qualified applicants planning a career in education, but this is not a requirement of the application process.

**How recipients will be selected:** Personal data sheets showing student name, address, phone number will be removed from application forms by the high school counselor. Members of the USD #429 Logan and Vera Dean Estate Fund Committee will then review the essays, and select the award winners. It should be noted that the overall quality of the applicant's essay, including neatness, completeness, spelling, grammar, and attention to detail, will play an important part in the selection process, as these were treasured standards set for her students by Mrs. Dean. The committee reserves the right to withhold one or both awards in any given year if, in the opinion of the committee, appropriate applications have not been received.

**How students may apply:**

1. Obtain application information and forms from the Troy High School Counselor. The counselor may establish the date when materials are due.
2. Fill in the attached personal data sheet.
3. On a separate sheet submit an essay detailing your future plans. This essay may be no longer than one page, and should be word processed. Do not include your name on the essay.

**When applications will be accepted:** The deadline for applications is April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.
